Exploring Treatment Options For Morton's Neuroma

Typically a Morton's Neuroma is treated with orthotics therapy. The aim of this therapy is to reconstruct the transverse arch in hopes that the digital nerve will no longer be compressed. For those patients who are not responsive to conservative treatment, Medical Foot Solutions provides an innovative, minimally invasive surgical option to decompress the inter-metatarsal space. Decompression surgery is the preferred choice of management because it leaves the digital nerve intact. This minimally invasive procedure is performed in office using local anesthesia. A #15 blade is used to create a 7mm vertical incision into the web space. Since the incision is made between the metatarsals, the neurovascular bundles are protected. Hemostasis is achieved through a combination of an ankle tourniquet and epinephrine. The tissues are separated and the transverse metatarsal ligament is located using a specialized instrument, called the Koby-Guard instrument. This instrument isolates the transverse metatarsal ligament, while protecting the surrounding tissue. The transverse ligament is responsible for maintaining the metatarsal alignment in the transverse plane. Once the KobyGuard instrument is properly positioned, a cutting blade is introduced and the transverse metatarsal ligament is severed. This results in the separation of the metatarsals and thereby a reduction of compressive forces on the digital nerve. The patient is able to ambulate immediately and the associated pain tends to gradually diminish over several weeks.

Typical Patient Presentation

- A feeling as if you are standing on a pebble in your shoe.
- A burning pain in the ball of your foot that may radiate into your toes.
- Tingling or numbness in your toes.
